ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Southern Pacific Transportation Company (SPT) filed a Petition for Extension of Time on October 21, 1988, requesting that the authority granted by Decision (D.) 85-10-032 in Application (A.) 85-06-053 and D.88-03-051 in A.87-12-007, which authorized the railroad to construct a drill track at grade across Wall Street in Ontario, San Bernardino County, be extended to December 1, 1989.


The Commission by Resolution TED-13-Safety Division, dated May 25, 1989, granted an extension of time to December 1, 1989, to exercise the authority granted by D.88-03-051 in A.87-12-007 and D.85-10-032 in A.85-06-053. The resolution was issued pursuant to Resolution ET-1367 and Memorandum by the Executive Director dated April 6, 1988.

Since SPT's request has been granted by Resolution TED-13, the Petition for Extension of Time will be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition for Extension of Time filed by Southern Pacific Transportation Company on October 21, 1988 is dismissed. This order is issued under Public Utilities Code Section 308 and Resolution A-4638. In all other respects D.85-10-032 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order is effective 30 days from today.
