OPINION

California Moving and Storage Association (petitioner) is a non-profit corporation which represents the interests of household goods carriers.

Minimum Rate Tariff (MRT) 4-C contains rules for estimating charges by such carriers (cf. Decision (D.) 87-10-001). The rules in Items 108 and 112 prescribe an Estimated Cost of Services form (Item 420) and specify a Basis for Carrier's Estimated Cost of Service form (Item 400). The former document is prepared and given to the shipper on request, only after a visual inspection of the goods to be moved.

Petitioner requests that the two forms be consolidated on an optional basis into a single form. Because of size and typesetting considerations, petitioner requests that the tariff be modified to permit smaller print for the titles of the two documents. The reduction will be from a type size of not less than 1/2 and 1/4 inch high to a 1/8 inch high type face. Without the change, it would not be possible to have both forms appear on a single sheet of paper.

It also requests changes in the types of household goods listed on the reverse of the form. These changes, it says, will make the items conform more closely to the types of furniture and household equipment owned by today's families. For example the

categories "Mangle" and "Incinerator" are to be eliminated, while "Microwave" is to be added. For another example, "Davenport" is to be changed to "Sofa."

Petitioner also recommends that duplication between the two documents be eliminated. It proposes that an additional service be added for use in Item 400 when additional equipment is required.

Transportation Division Staff has negotiated with petitioner to recommend additional modifications to the form. The proposed forms meet with Transportation Division's approval.

The application and amendment were listed on the Daily Transportation Calendars of April 25, 1988 and March 8, 1989 respectively. Since there have been no protests, we find that no hearing is necessary.

Some corrections will also be made in Items 60, 340, and 470.

Findings of Fact

1. No hearing is necessary.
2. The proposed changes to forms and to tariff items are not controversial and are not adverse to the public interest.

Conclusion of Law

The application, as amended, should be granted.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff (MRT) 4-C (Appendix D to Decision 87-01-066, as amended) is further amended by incorporating the attached revised tariff pages listed in Appendix A, to become effective 39 days after today.
2. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed on or after the effective date of this order and may be made effective not earlier

than the 10th day after the effective date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than 10 days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than 60 days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

3. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on each subscriber to MRT 4-C.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.

When delivery is completed, the carrier will ask you to sign the delivery receipt, the inventory sheet, or both. When you sign, it is a good idea to note any lost or damaged goods. This may simplify processing of any future claims. However, failure to do so in no way affects your right to make a claim and to have the claim considered on its merits.

IF YOUR NEW HOME IS NOT READY

If you cannot move into your new home or apartment immediately, you may wish to have your goods moved from your present residence and held in storage for later delivery. For a storage period of 90 days or less, you can request "Storage-in-Transit" (abbreviated SIT). Separate charges will be assessed for the transportation from your old place of residence into storage, for the SIT, and for the transportation to your new residence. Storage and handling charges will be assessed for this service and it will be covered by the terms and conditions of your agreement with the moving company. If you do not request "Storage-in-Transit," or if your storage period exceeds 90 days, your goods will be subject to rates, terms, and conditions set by the local warehouse and the service will be under a separate contract with the warehouseman and not regulated by the PUC.
