FINAL OPINION AND ORDER

This investigation was instituted to determine whether Ridgecrest Heights Land and Water Company (Ridgecrest), a public utility water company within the meaning of Public Utilities Code Sections 216 and 241, should be ordered to upgrade its system.

By Interim Decision (D.) 82-11-043 in this proceeding, we directed Ridgecrest to file with this Commission an application for approval of a Department of Water Resources loan and an appropriate customer surcharge to repay the loan.

By D.87-07-003, dated July 8, 1987, in Application (A.) 86-06-032, Ridgecrest was authorized to sell and transfer its water system to the Indian Wells Valley Water District. Ridgecrest was relieved of its public utility obligations upon compliance with the terms and conditions of D.87-07-003. The Commission has been furnished with copies of all necessary transfer documents. The transfer was made on February 19, 1988. In the circumstances, this investigation should be discontinued.
