ORDER CORRECTING DECISION 89-08-025

Decision (D.) 89-08-025 dated August 3, 1989 authorized the County of Orange (the County) and the City of San Clemente (the City) to construct an at-grade crossing across the tracks of the Atchison, Topeka, and Santa Fe Railroad Company in San Clemente.

D.89-08-029 granted the application and specified which party or parties would be responsible for providing, constructing or installing, and maintaining various components of the project. Through inadvertent error D.89-08-029 included the railroad as a responsible party for fencing associated with the project.

Accordingly, under Resolution A-4661,

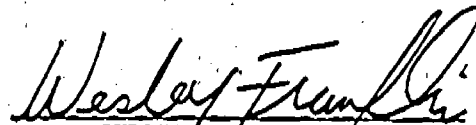
IT IS ORDERED that the Findings and Ordering Paragraphs of D.89-08-025 are amended as follows:

1. Delete from Finding 12 the words "associated fencing."
2. Add Finding 12a to read: "Provision and construction of the associated fencing is the responsibility of the County and the City."
3. Delete from Ordering Paragraph 5 the comma after the word "protection," and delete the words "and the fencing."
4. Add Ordering Paragraph 5a to read: "The fencing shall be provided, constructed, installed, and maintained at the entire expense of the County and the City."

5. Amend Ordering Paragraph 6 to read: "The authorized at-grade pedestrian crossing and the automatic crossing protection, after installation, shall be repaired and maintained by Sante Fe at the City's entire expense."

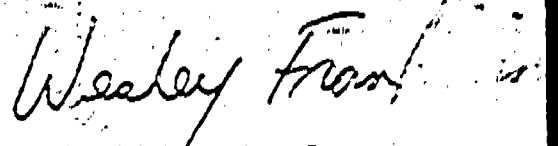
This order is effective today.
