ORDER GRANTING LIMITED REHEARING

On December 4, 1989 Telesphere Network, Inc. (Telesphere) applied for a Partial Stay of I&S C.89-11-020 ordering paragraph two which finds that Advice Letters Nos. 8 and 9 are suspended pending the outcome of the investigation. On December 8, 1989 Telesphere filed an Application for Rehearing of I&S C.89-11-020 requesting that a hearing be held before Advice Letters Nos. 8 and 9 are suspended. The Commission has reviewed the Application and has found that there is good cause to grant Telesphere a limited rehearing. The sole purpose for granting a limited rehearing is to determine whether Telesphere's Advice Letters Nos. 8 and 9 should be suspended pending the outcome of the investigation to determine whether Advice Letters Nos. 8 and 9 are unreasonable or unlawful in any respect. Shortly after the conclusion of this limited rehearing, an order will issue setting forth the hearing schedule for the investigation ordered in I&S C.89-11-020. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Telesphere's Application for Rehearing is granted for the limited purpose of holding a hearing to determine whether Telesphere's Advice Letters Nos. 8 and 9 should be suspended pending the outcome of the investigation ordered in I&S C.89-11-020. (1&S) C.89-11-020 L/GTD/1mz .

2. The limited rehearing on this matter will be	held on
January 24, 1990 before Administrative Law Judge Bert	Mattson.
