<u>O P I N I Ó N</u>

Complainant seeks to be relieved of paying the indebtedness of the previous user for Wide Area Telephone Service (WATS) line phone numbers to which complainant succeeded pursuant to defendant's supersedure tariff, Schedule Cal PUC No. C-1. Complainant has deposited the amount in dispute, \$4,738.89, with the Commission.

In May 1988 complainant superseded to the WATS lines of Cherokee Village Resorts (Cherokee). Defendant's supersedure tariff requires that the new customer assume all the outstanding indebtedness of the old customer. At the time of the supersedure Cherokee owed defendant \$4,738.89 for its WATS line. Complainant asserts that prior to its superseding to the service it was told by defendant that it did not have to pay the outstanding indebtedness of Cherokee. Defendant asserts that complainant was fully informed of its obligations under the supersedure tariff. Public hearing was set for December 18, 1989. Defendant appeared but complainant

did not. A telephone call was placed by the presiding officer to complainant, which informed the presiding officer that it would not appear.

Finding of Fact

Complainant was notified of the time and place of hearing and failed to appear.

Conclusion of Law

The complaint should be dismissed with prejudice and the money on deposit be paid to defendant.

IT IS ORDERED that the complaint is dismissed with prejudice and the Executive Director is directed to pay to defendant the money on deposit with the Commission in this case.
