## OPINION MODIFYING DECISION

On January 5, 1990, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) filed a petition for modification of Decision (D.) 89-12-016, our decision resolving issues relating to gas gathering. This decision grants PG&E's petition.

pG&E's petition asks the Commission to change its gas gathering order so that PG&E is not required, as D.89-12-016 directs, to file a rate proposal in its pending 1990 Annual Cost Allocation Proceeding (ACAP) allocating some of its gathering costs to interutility rates. PG&E states the requirement would require the development of a modified forecast in its ACAP. Such an adjustment is likely to be controversial, according to PG&E, and hearings have concluded in that case.

We agree with PG&E that it is reasonable to defer allocation of gathering costs to another proceeding. We will modify D.89-12-016 to require that PG&E propose an allocation of gathering costs to interutility rates in its 1991 ACAP application. Pindings of Fact

- 1. D.89-12-016 directed PG&E to file, in its 1990 ACAP, a proposal to allocate gathering costs to its interutility rates.
  - 2. The record in PG&E's 1990 ACAP is closed.

Conclusion of Law

D.89-12-016 should be modified to direct PG&E to file a proposal to allocate gathering costs to interutility rates in its 1991 ACAP.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

Ordering Paragraph 2 of Decision 89-12-016 is amended to read "PG&E shall file, in its 1991 Annual Cost Allocation Proceeding, a rate proposal allocating an equal share of gas gathering costs, on a cents per therm basis, to interutility rates and transportation rates."

This order is effective today.
