ORDER AUTHORIZING SUBSTITUTION OF  
APPLICANT AND PARTIAL DISMISSAL

In Application (A.) 89-05-004 CN Communications (CNC) requested a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPCN) to provide exchange telephone service in Toiyabe (eastern Sierra County) and Cima (eastern San Bernardino County). On February 6, 1990, CNC and The Ponderosa Telephone Co. (Ponderosa) jointly filed a "First Amendment to Application" to substitute Ponderosa in place of and instead of CNC as applicant and to withdraw from, and delete all references to, the proposed Toiyabe exchange in that application. Ponderosa intends to pursue only construction of the proposed Cima exchange.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The portion of the application seeking a CPCN in the Toiyabe exchange is dismissed without prejudice.


2. The Ponderosa Telephone Co. is hereby recognized as the successor to CN Communications as the applicant seeking authority to establish the remaining proposed Cima exchange.
