ORDER DENYING REHEARING AND MODIFYING D.90-01-014

GTE CALIFORNIA, INCORPORATED (GTEC) has filed an application for rehearing of Decision (D.) 90-01-014. We have considered all the allegations of error in the application and are of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been shown. Although we feel we have made ourselves clear on the pertinent issues, it is possible that an unsophisticated person unfamiliar with our past decisions could misconstrue Conclusion of Law No. 4 as it is written. We will modify D.90-01-014 to further clarify our intentions. Therefore,


IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Rehearing of D.90-01-014 is hereby denied.
2. Conclusion of Law No. 4 of D.90-01-014 is hereby modified to read: "Complainants should not be granted relief from charges for calls that are not to 976 programs, or charges such as tolls for access to 976 numbers."
