ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

On January 9, 1990, the complaint of Consolidated Fiber Glass Products Company (Conglas) was denied in Decision (D.) 90-01-018. Complainant's petition for rehearing was denied on March 14, 1990 by D.90-03-044.

Complainant had deposited \$43,099.20 with the Commission when it first brought the issue to the Commission's Consumer Affairs Branch for informal resolution. That sum was a portion of the \$348,145.07 that Pacific Gas and Electric (PG&E) was required by D.90-01-018 to collect from Conglas. However, D.90-01-018 failed to authorize the release of the amount on deposit with the Commission to PG&E.

Under Resolution A-4661,


IT IS ORDERED that the following language shall be added to the end of the first paragraph on page 14 of the mimeographed version of D.90-01-018:

The Fiscal Office of the Commission shall disburse \$43,099.20, which is the amount that complainant Conglas had deposited with the Commission prior to the filing of the instant

complaint, to defendant PG&E. The \$43,099.20 should be credited to Conglas' liability for backbilling so that the amount to be collected directly from Conglas should be \$305,045.88.

This order is effective today.


