O P I N I O N

Decision (D.) 89-02-018 in this matter and in Application (A.) 88-01-013 granted a rate increase and severed this matter for separate decision.¹

We take official notice that Dunsmuir Water Corporation has disposed of both of its systems and is no longer a public utility corporation.

We conclude that this matter is moot and should be dismissed.

¹ This corporation owned two systems, one serving Dunsmuir and the other serving the City of Fort Jones. D.89-07-027 in A.89-03-018 authorized the City of Dunsmuir to acquire all stock in the corporation, and to transfer the Fort Jones system to the shareholders as partners pending sale of that system to Fort Jones. It also disposed of a trust fund of accumulated Safe Drinking Water Bond Act surcharges. The disposition of this fund was the primary unresolved issue in this proceeding.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that this application is dismissed.


