## ORDER MODIFYING DECISION 90-03-035 AND DENYING REHEARING

The Woods, Cherry Avenue Development Company, Arcadia Management Services Company and Arcadia Development Company have filed an application for rehearing of Decision (D.) 90-03-035. We have considered all of the allegations of error raised in this application and have concluded that sufficient grounds for rehearing have not been shown. However, we believe that one of the findings in the decision should be modified in order to more accurately reflect the record in this case. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that D.90-03-035 is modified as follows:

1. The sentence beginning on the last line of page 7 is modified to read:

Complainants' meters are for residential use, which suggests that they are displacement meters, and complainants did not meet their burden of proving that their meters are other than displacement meters.

2. Finding of Fact No. 11 on page 10 is modified to read:

11. Complainants did not meet their burden of proving that their meters are other than displacement meters and therefore are not exceptions to Rule 17B. PG&E's billing computers are not "other appliances" within the meaning of Rule 17B.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that rehearing of D.90-03-035 as modified herein is denied.
