**SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS,  
AND SPECIFICATIONS.**

Charles E. Allred, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport passengers and baggage on an on-call basis between the community of Sutter, the Cities of Live Oak, Marysville, Yuba City, and Wheatland, and Beale Air Force Base, on the one hand, and Sacramento Metropolitan Airport (SMA), on the other hand, over and along the routes described in Section 3, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify the route at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- (a) This certificate does not authorize the holder to conduct any operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by the airport authority involved.
- (b) When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operations in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- (c) No passengers shall be transported except those having a point of origin or destination at SMA.
- (d) The term "on-call" as used refers to service which is authorized to be rendered dependent on the demands of passengers. The tariffs and timetables shall show the conditions under which the authorized door-to-door, on-call service will be provided, and shall include the description of the boundary of each fare zone, except when a single fare is charged to all points within a single incorporated city.
