ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

By this application Southern California Gas Company (SoCalGas) invokes the Commission's authority pursuant to the California Constitution, Article 12, Section 5 and Public Utilities (PU) Code §§ 701, 1351, and 1401, et seq. to fix the just compensation which shall be paid by applicant, under the law, for the taking of certain lands, properties, and rights owned by Southern Pacific Transportation Company, a public utility as defined by California Constitution, Article 12, Section 3, and by PU Code § 230.

The following is a description of the interest in the real property sought to be condemned:

"General description of Right-of-Way 8752.
Pipeline No. 2000.

'Strip of land, varying in width from 10 feet to 15 feet, beginning at Birch Street in the City of Brea; thence westerly and northwesterly a distance of approximately 10.76 miles, within and parallel to the Southern Pacific Railroad corridor; to the point of termination east of Sorensen Avenue in the City of Santa Fe Springs, as shown on map identified and attached to the application as Exhibit A.'

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Southern Pacific Transportation Company shall appear before Administrative Law Judge Orville I. Wright in the

Commission's Courtroom on Friday, December 14, 1990, at 10:00 a.m., ✓
at 505 Van Ness Avenue, San Francisco, California, to show cause,
if any it has, why the Commission should not proceed to hear the
application and to fix the just compensation to be paid for the
lands, property, and rights described above.

2. The Executive Director of the Commission is directed to
serve a certified copy of this Order to Show Cause upon Southern
Pacific Transportation Company with a copy of the application
attached thereto, by United States mail, enclosed in a sealed
envelope, registered, with postage prepaid, addressed as follows:

3. The Executive Director is further directed to serve a
copy of this Order to Show Cause upon the applicant by regular
mail.


