Application for hearing of U. C. Moving Services, Inc. (Re: suspension, revocation, or denial of renewal authority of property or passenger carrier at request of California Highway Patrol.)

O P I N I O N

This application by U. C. Moving Services, Inc. (UC) was filed to contest the suspension of UC's operating authority by the Director of Transportation at the request of the California Highway Patrol (CHP). The reason for the request was an unsatisfactory safety rating. (Public Utilities Code § 1070.5.) UC holds highway common carrier, contract and household goods authority under T-159566.

A hearing was set for May 17, 1990. The matter was taken off calendar, because the CHP had reinspected and issued a satisfactory safety rating.

On June 20, 1990, the Director of Transportation reinstated the authority.

Finding of Fact

We find that this proceeding is now moot.

Conclusion of Law

This application should therefore be dismissed with a ratification of the Director's action.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the application is dismissed as moot and the Director's reinstatement of authority is ratified.


