O P I N I O N

Applicant North State Communications, Inc. seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct additional antennas to operate on 454.425 MHz. It now provides one-way paging and two-way mobile telephone service in Sacramento, Oroville, Redding, and Red Bluff. The new antennas will expand its service area; it claims to have received requests for service in the expanded area.

The cost of the new facilities will be \$33,000. They will be located in Chico, on an existing antenna site.

The application was noticed in the Commission's Daily Calendar on June 15, 1990. No protests have been received.

Findings of Fact

1. No protests have been received.
2. Public convenience and necessity require the proposed service area expansion.
3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

Conclusions of Law

1. No hearing is required.
2. The application should be granted.

3. Since this order is not controversial, it should be effective today.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is issued to North State Communications, Inc. for the construction and operation of the antenna facility as specified in the application.

2. Within 30 days after this order is effective, applicant shall file a written acceptance of the certificate granted in this proceeding.


3. The certificate granted and the authority to render service under the rates, charges, and rules authorized will expire if not exercised within 12 months after the effective date of this order.

4. After the effective date of this order, North State Communications, Inc. shall file revised tariffs and service area maps in compliance with General Order Series 96, and apply its present tariffs to the areas certificated by this order. The effective date of these tariffs shall be 5 days after filing.

This order is effective today.
