OPINION

On June 8, 1990, the City of Long Beach (Long Beach) filed a Petition for Modification of Decision (D.) 90-01-015. D.90-01-015 resolved most issues in Southern California Gas Company's (SoCalGas) annual cost allocation proceeding (ACAP). The petition seeks modification (1) to provide for balancing account treatment of lost and unaccounted for gas costs allocated to wholesale customers; (2) to allow Long Beach to address in SoCalGas' 1990 ACAP the proper allocation of Women and Minority Business Enterprises program administrative costs; and (3) to order cash refunds to customers of certain interstate supplier refunds received by SoCalGas.

SoCalGas and Division of Ratepayer Advocates (DRA) protested the Petition for Modification in filings dated July 9, 1990.

Long Beach's request seeks modifications to D.90-01-015 on issues which the Commission has already considered or which are appropriately the subjects of other proceedings. We will deny Long Beach's petition.

Findings of Fact

1. Long Beach seeks modifications to D.90-01-015 on topics which have already been addressed by the Commission or which are appropriately subjects of other proceedings.

2. DRA and SoCalGas protested Long Beach's petition to modify D.90-01-015.

Conclusion of Law

Long Beach's Petition for Modification of D.90-01-015 should be denied.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the Petition for Modification of D.90-01-015 filed by the City of Long Beach on June 8, 1990 is denied.

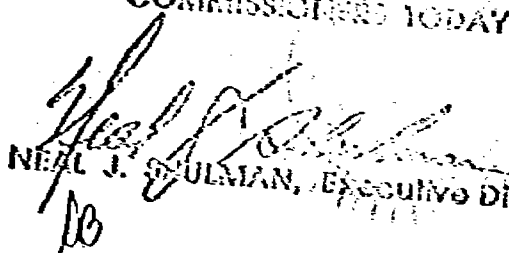
