OPINION

A&A Réady Mixed Concrete Inc. (petitioner) is a California corporation located in Gardena, California.

Petitioner requests a modification of Minimum Rate Tariff (MRT) 17-A and Southern California Production Area and Delivery Zone Directory No. 1, by adding new delivery points to Section 3 (Area-to-Point Rates) of MRT 17-A for Item 60 commodities. Petitioner further requests that the Commission modify a delivery point designation to reflect a change of plant ownership, and correct a Delivery Zone designation error.

Petitioner now receives rock, sand, and gravel from Los Angeles County for use in its ready-mixed concrete batch plants located at the following Los Angeles County locations:

> 100 E. Redondo Beach Boulevard Gardena, CA 90248 Delivery Zone 19220

1361 W. Sepulveda Boulevard Torrance, CA 90501 Delivery Zone 19238

1650 B. Spring Street Signal Hill, CA 90806 Delivery Zone 19465 Petitioner purchased the latter location in December 1982 from Dewey and Bobs Ready Mixed Concrete; this is the location petitioner requests the delivery point designation be modified to reflect the ownership change.

Petitioner requests that MRT 17-A, Ninth Rovised Page 3-1 dated March 25, 1990 be corrected to indicate that its 134 W. Redondo Beach Boulevard, Gardena plant is in Delivery Zone 19225; the Delivery Zone is shown incorrectly as 19925. We will order this correction.

Petitioner receives aggregates as set forth above from for-hire dump truck operators it engages to transport the items from designated production areas to its various delivery points.

Petitioner's plants qualify for the 3-cent per ton rate reduction according to the following information furnished by petitioner:

- Petitioner has received, or expects to receive, 1,000 tons or more per year.
- Petitioner's facilities include space for bunker reception or stock piling of rock and sand in quantities of at least 50 tons at a time.
- 3. Petitioner's plants have adequate space to provide the required 150-foot clearance around parked trucks and trailers waiting to unload.
- 4. Petitioner maintains personnel on duty while transporting service is being furnished, for the purpose of signing delivery tickets and performing other functions necessary to the receipt of shipments.
- 5. The average loading and unloading time for a dump truck and trailer combination does not exceed 30 minutes per 24 tons.

Item 3000 of Section 3 of MRT 17-A is quoted as follows: *APPLICATION OF AREA-TO-POINT RATES

"Area-to-Point Rates are the rates set forth in Item 3020 and apply to the Delivery Points listed in this section from Production Areas located in Los Angeles County (excépt Antelope Valley/Mojave Desert portion thereof), Orange County, Riverside County, San Bernardino County (except antelope Valley/Mojave Desert portion thereof), San Diego County and Ventura County for the commodities described in Item 60 only.

"Unless otherwise specifically provided within this section, there is no applicable Area-to-Point Rate to a Delivery Point if no zone rate is provided within this tariff."

Item 3020 of Section 3 is set forth below: *AREA-TO-POINT RATES

"The Area-to-Point Rates described in Item 3000 shall be 3 cents per ton less than the otherwise applicable zone rates to the appropriate Delivery Zone."

A "List of Delivery Points" is provided following Item 3020. Each delivery point is identified by the name of the company occupying the land, and an address including house or lot number, street, and city, town, or other designation. Each location is also within a numbered Delivery Zone described in Directory 1.

The application was noticed in the Commission's Daily Transportation Calendar on April 20, 1990. There have been no protests or requests for hearing.

The Commission's Transportation Division recommends that the application be granted.

Pindings of Fact

- 1. Pétitioner has applied to qualify its plants in Torrance and 100 B. Redondo Beach Boulevard, Gardena, as Delivery Points under Item 3020 of Section 3 of MRT 17-A.
- 2. Petitioner requests the Delivery Point designation of its Signal Hill plant be modified to reflect a change of ownership.

- 3. Petitioner receives 1,000 tons or more of aggregates per year, and has storage capacity and the necessary area to provide a turnaround for loaded trucks and trailers.
- 4. Petitioner can complete loading or unloading of 24 tons in 30 minutes or less, and has personnel on duty while transporting service is being furnished.
 - 5. The proposed rates are reasonable.
- 6. MRT 17-A, Ninth Revised Page 3-1 dated March 25, 1990 incorrectly indicates that Petitioner's 134 W. Redondo Beach Boulevard, Gardena plant is in Delivery Zone 19925. The correct Delivery Zone is 19225.
- A public hearing is not necessary.
 Conclusions of Law
- 1. Section 3 of MRT 17-A should be amended to include petitioner's addresses of new Delivery Points; 1361 W. Sepulvedá Boulevard, Torrance and 100 E. Redondo Beach Boulevard, Gardena and to reflect the Signal Hill plant change of ownership.
- 2. Petitioner's 134 W. Redondo Beach Boulevard, Gardena Delivery Zone should be corrected.
- 3. The petition should be granted to the extent provided in the following order.
- 4. The effective date of this order should be today because there is an immediate need for the rate relief.

ORDBR

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Section 3 of Minimum Rate Tariff (MRT) 17-A (Appendix C to Decision (D.) 80578, as amended) is further amended by incorporating Tenth Revised Page 3-1 and Tenth Revised Page 3-2, attached, to become effective 30 days after today.
- 2. In all other respects, D.80578, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
