ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

It has come to our attention that Surcharge Supplement 44 to Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A accompanying Decision 90-08-047 does not reflect the Commission's intent to except Item 570, Tarp Labor Charge, from the current surcharges.

In order to correct this error, the decision should be amended as set forth in the ensuing order.

Pursuant to Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A (Appendix C to Decision 80578, as amended) is further amended by incorporating Supplement 46, attached, to be effective today.
2. In all other respects, Decision 90-08-047, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
3. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on each subscriber to Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A.

DUMP TRUCK CARRIERS

(E) APPLICATION OF SURCHARGE

Except as otherwise provided, compute the amount of charges in accordance with the rates and rules of this tariff, and increase the amount so computed as follows:
(SEE EXCEPTION)

1. By one and three-tenths (1.3) percent on commodities named in Items 60, 70 and 75 except for the transportation of commodities in permanently enclosed hoppers.
2. By eight-tenths (0.8) percent for the transportation of commodities described in Item 65 and commodities in permanently enclosed hoppers.

For purposes of disposing of fractions under provisions hereof, fractions of less than one-half (1/2) cent shall be dropped and fractions of one-half (1/2) cent or greater shall be increased to the next higher whole cent.

EXCEPTION: The surcharge herein shall not apply to:

1. Paragraphs (b) and (c) in Item 120 - Application of Tariff--Rates;
2. Item 170 - Accessorial Charges (At Origin);
3. The additional charge in Item 180 when transportation is performed in 4- and 5-axle equipment - Accessorial Charges (At Destination);
4. Items 200 and 220 (Railhead-to-railhead charges only);
5. Item 280 - Collect on Delivery (C.O.D.) Shipment; and
- *6. Item 570 - Tarp Labor Charge.
