ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

It has come to our attention that Surcharge Supplement 28 to Minimum Rate Tariff 20 accompanying Decision 90-08-048 does not reflect the Commission's intent to except Item 195, Tarp Labor Charge, from the current surcharges.

In order to correct this error, the decision should be amended as set forth in the ensuing order.

Pursuant to Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 20 (Appendix A to Decision 81799, as amended) is further amended by incorporating Supplement 30, attached, to be effective today.
2. In all other respects, Decision 90-08-048, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
3. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on each subscriber to Minimum Rate Tariff 20.

This order is effective today.

SURCHARGE SUPPLEMENT

(E) SUPPLEMENT 30
(Cancels Supplement 28)
(Supplements 2, 7, 27, 29 and 30 Contain All Changes)
TO
MINIMUM RATE TARIFF 20
NAMING
MINIMUM ZONE RATES AND RULES
FOR THE
TRANSPORTATION OF ROCK, SAND AND GRAVEL
IN FOUR- AND FIVE-AXLE DUMP TRUCK EQUIPMENT FROM
DEFINED PRODUCTION AREAS TO DESIGNATED DELIVERY ZONES
AND DISTANCE RATES
IN NORTHERN CALIFORNIA
BY
DUMP TRUCK CARRIERS

(E) APPLICATION OF SURCHARGE

Except as otherwise provided, compute the amount of charges in accordance with the rates and rules of this tariff, and increase the amount so computed as follows:
(SEE EXCEPTION)

1. By one and three-tenths (1.3) percent except when transported in permanently enclosed hoppers.
2. By eight-tenths (0.8) percent when transported in permanently enclosed hoppers.

For purposes of disposing of fractions under provisions hereof, fractions of less than one-half (1/2) cent shall be dropped and fractions of one-half (1/2) cent or greater shall be increased to the next higher whole cent.

EXCEPTION: The surcharge herein shall not apply to:

- *1. Item 195 - Tarp Labor Charge;
2. Items 200 and 220 (Railhead-to-railhead charges only); and
3. Item 280 - Collect on Delivery (C.O.D.) Shipment.
