INTERIN OPINION

On August 8, 1990, the Commission in Decision (D.) 90-08-027 granted Contel Cellular of California, Inc. (Contel) temporary authority to operate a single temporary cell site at a location in Imperial County for up to 90 days from the date of the decision.

The Commission Advisory and Compliance Division (CACD) is presently reviewing Contel's request for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. As part of its review CACD issued a proposed Negative Declaration for comment. It is now apparent that there will be insufficient time for CACD to review the comments and for the Commission to act before the 90-day temporary operating authority will expire. An extension of 30 days will bridge the gap between the date when the temporary operating authority expires and when the Commission will be able to consider applicant's request.

If Contel's temporary operating authority does expire, it cannot legally remain in service, and consequently Contel's permit issued by the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) could be terminated. Since it is not in the public interest for Contel's FCC permit to be terminated, Contel should be granted an extension of time of 30 days. A.90-03-042 AIJ/BDP/gn
