ORDER CLOSING DOCKET

On August 24, 1990, counsel for the Compliance and Enforcement Branch of the Transportation Division wrote to the administrative law judge recommending that the proceeding be closed. Counsel represents that LCO Enterprises, Inc., carrier-respondent, is in a bankruptcy proceeding that may lead to reorganization. The undercharges sought in this investigation would be an unsecured claim in such a bankruptcy proceeding. Counsel advises that the cost of pursuing such an unsecured claim in the bankruptcy court, together with the uncertainty of prevailing over secured creditors, indicate that further continuation of this investigation is not warranted. We agree that this investigation should be discontinued.

IT IS ORDERED that this investigation is terminated and the docket is closed.
