ORDER CORRECTING PRIOR DECISION

It has come to our attention that Ordering Paragraphs 5 and 13 in Decision (D.) 90-06-029, issued June 6, 1990, are in conflict. Ordering Paragraph 5 requires that META file copies of its FCC permit for its Sacramento paging site within 90 days of the effective date of D.90-06-029. Ordering Paragraph 13 requires the filing within 180 days of the effective date and contains a clerical error.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Ordering Paragraph 5 in D.90-06-029 is amended to read as follows:

"5. Within 180 days of the effective date of this order, applicant shall file two copies of the FCC construction permit for its proposed site in Sacramento. Two copies of the permit will be filed with the Director of the Commission Advisory and Compliance Division (CACD) who will place one copy in the formal file for this application in our Central Files."

2. Ordering Paragraph 13 is amended to read as follows:

"13. The certificate granted and the authority to render service under the rates, charges, and rules authorized will expire if applicant has not filed the remaining FCC construction permit required in Ordering Paragraph 5 within 180

days of the effective date of this order, or if the certificate is not exercised within 12 months after applicant has complied with Ordering Paragraph 5."


This order is effective today.
