ORDER DENYING REHEARING OR MODIFICATION

California Energy Company, Inc., has filed an application for rehearing of Decision No. 90-09-059. The Commission has considered each and every allegation of the application and is of the opinion that rehearing should be denied.

Southern California Edison Company has filed a petition for modification of Decision No. 90-09-059 to authorize ex parte filing of an updated cost estimate in this proceeding. Section 1005.5 of the Public Utilities Code requires that any increased cost estimate be approved upon the filing of an application, rather than pursuant to a petition for modification under Rule 43 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Accordingly, the petition should be denied.

Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that rehearing of Decision No. 90-09-059 is denied.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company's petition for modification of Decision No. 90-09-059 is denied.
