ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

This decision corrects a clerical error in Decision (D.) 90-12-100, issued December 20, 1990. The decision addresses several petitions for modification of D.90-09-089. The discussion in D.90-12-100 makes clear our intent to deny a request made by Southern California Gas Company to continue to permit gas utilities to impose demand charges on utility electric generation (UEG) customers. Conclusion of Law 1, however, states that the Commission should modify D.90-09-089 to provide that UEG customers will continue to pay demand charges.

This decision corrects the clerical error in Conclusion of Law 1 by providing that D.90-09-089 should not be modified to require UEG customers to pay demand charges.

IT IS ORDERED that Conclusion of Law 1 in Decision 90-12-100 is modified as follows:

The Commission should not modify D.90-09-089 to provide that UEG customers shall continue to pay demand charges for transportation services.
