ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING

This investigation was instituted for the purpose of allowing respondent Viking Freight System, Inc. (Viking) to show cause why it should not be ordered to cancel certain tariffs containing what appeared to be shipper-specific rates, because they are based on extremely specific nine digit zip codes as shipping points, contrary to Decision 90-02-021.

In its response dated July 20, 1990, Viking stated it would forthwith either cancel or revise the tariffs in question to eliminate the nine digit zip codes contained therein. The Commission's Transportation Division has advised that Viking has accomplished the revisions of the tariffs cited in the investigation. In the circumstances, the investigation should be discontinued.

Findings of Fact

1. This investigation was instituted to allow Viking to show cause why it should not be ordered to cancel certain tariffs containing what appeared to shipper-specific rates.
2. Viking has revised the tariffs in question by eliminating the nine digit zip codes contained therein.

Conclusion of Law

This investigation should be discontinued.


IT IS ORDERED that Investigation 90-06-034 is discontinued.
