ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

On November 21, 1990, the Commission issued Decision (D.) 90-11-067 granting Metropolitan Paratransit Company's (MPC) request for authority to expand its passenger stage operations, among other things.

Conclusion of Law 2 in D.90-11-067 makes clear that the Commission intended to grant MPC's request to expand its authority, a request which included service to the Ontario International Airport. The Appendix to D.90-11-067 which specifies MPC's authorized territory, however, omits reference to Ontario International Airport. The omission is a clerical error.


This decision corrects the clerical error in the Appendix to D.90-11-067 by including reference to Ontario International Airport as part of MPC's authorized service territory.

Under Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that the Appendix to Decision 90-11-067 is amended to clarify that Metropolitan Paratransit Company's authorized service territory includes the Ontario International Airport, as set forth in the appendix attached to this decision.

This order is effective today.



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SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS,  
AND SPECIFICATIONS.

Century Transit System, Inc., by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to transport passengers and their baggage, on-call basis, between certain points in the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange, Riverside and San Bernardino, described in Section 2, and the Los Angeles International (LAX), Burbank (BUR), Long Beach (LGB), John Wayne (SNA) and \*Ontario (ONT) Airports, on the one hand, and scheduled service between certain hotels in the City of West Hollywood, described in Section 3, and LAX, on the other hand, over and along the routes described in Section 3, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify the route at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- (a) This certificate does not authorize the holder to conduct any operations on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by the airport authority involved.
- (b) When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operations in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- (c) No passengers shall be transported except those having a point of origin or destination at LAX, BUR, LGB, SNA or \*ONT.
- (d) The term "on-call" as used refers to service which is authorized to be rendered dependent on the demands of passengers. The tariffs and timetables shall show the conditions under which each authorized on-call service will be provided, and shall include the description of the boundary of each fare zone, except when a single fare is charged to all points within a single incorporated city.

SECTION 2. SERVICE AREA DESCRIPTIONS.

Los Angeles County

All points within the geographic limits of Los Angeles County.

Orange County

All points within the geographic limits of Orange County.

Riverside County

All points within the geographical limits of the Cities of Corona, Lake Elsinore, Moreno Valley, Norco, Perris, Riverside, and the following zip code communities: March Air Force Base, Mira Loma, Riverside County (92509, 92324, 92387), and Sun City.

San Bernardino County

All points within the geographical limits of the Cities of Chino, Colton, Etiwanda, Fontana, Grand Terrace, Highland, Loma Linda, Montclair, Ontario, Rancho Cucamonga, Redlands, Rialto, San Bernardino, Upland, and the following zip code communities: Alta Loma, Bloomington, Bryn Mawr, Guasti, Mount Baldy Village and Norton Air Force Base.

SECTION 3. ROUTE DESCRIPTIONS.

Route 1. On-Call Service

Commencing at LAX, BUR, LGB, SNA or \*ONT, then via the most convenient streets and highways to any point within the service areas described in Section 2.

Route 2. Scheduled Service

Commencing at LAX then over the most convenient route(s) to the following hotels:
