ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Marty Crowningshield (applicant) seeks authority to operate a passenger stage corporation between Manteca and Livermore.

On July 19, 1989, the Transportation Division (TD) filed a motion to dismiss the application. The motion shows that in May, June, and July of 1988 the TD staff wrote and telephoned the applicant several times to request additional information. Applicant provided some information, but he requested more time to provide other information. Staff continued its telephone inquiry of applicant through July and August 1988, but more information was not forthcoming. On December 30, 1988 staff sent a letter to applicant asking if he was still interested in pursuing his application. A response was not received and no further contact was made.


