ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO COMMENCE OPERATIONS

Decision (D.) 90-06-047 granted Signal One Paging, Inc. (Signal One) a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate one-way paging transmission facilities in San Diego, California. D.90-06-047 requires the system to be operational by June 20, 1991.

By letter dated May 23, 1991, Signal One requests that the date for commencing operations be extended to December 20, 1991 because their manager of development, construction, and operation met with a serious automobile accident.

Signal One's request was served on all competitors. No protests were received. We find no reason to deny the request.

IT IS ORDERED that Signal One Paging, Inc. is granted an extension until December 20, 1991 to commence operations. D.90-06-047 is modified accordingly.

This order is effective today.
