SECTION I. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS.

Bayporter Express, a corporation, by the *amended certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers and their baggage between points described in Section III, subject, however, to the authority of this commission to change or modify this authority at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- a. When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
- b. Daily scheduled service shall be provided on routes 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.
- c. "On-call" service shall be provided on routes A, B, and C. The term "on-call", as refers to service which is authorized to be rendered dependent on the demands of passengers. The tariffs and timetables shall show the conditions under which each authorized on-call service will be rendered.
- d. No passengers shall be transported except those having a point of origin or destination at either San Francisco (SFO), Oakland (OAK), or San Jose, International Airports.
- e. *Passengers originating from or destined to San Francisco shall only be transported to or from OAK.
- f. This certificate does not authorize the holder to conduct any operation on the property of or into any airport unless such operation is authorized by the airport authority involved.

SECTION II. SAN FRANCISCO BAY ON-CALL SERVICE AREAS.

BAY AREA COUNTY

Includes all points within the geographical limits of the counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, San Mateo, Santa Clara, and San Francisco (1).

*(1) Service is only between San Francisco and OAK.

Marin County

The boundary of this service area encompasses the part of Marin County between the Golden Gate Bridge on the south, two miles east and two miles west of Highway 101, and Lucas Valley-Smith Ranch Road exit on the north. Service shall be performed only between this service area and Oakland International Airport.
