OPINION

Complainant Charles H. Powell disputes the billing to a laundromat for a period when the gas meter was found to be not operating. For the billing period in question, April 9 to May 10, 1990, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) estimated the bill at \$402.48 based on complainant's usage for the same month in 1989.

Powell contests the legality of backbilling, and alleges that he is aware of similar instances in which PG&E did not backbill the customer. Powell does not disagree with PG&E's estimate of usage which results in the \$402.48 bill. A hearing on this complaint was held May 16, 1991.

There is no question about the legality of backbilling. Under PG&E's Tariff Rule 17, Section C.3; approved by the Commission, PG&E may bill a customer for the estimated gas service used but not metered. Powell offered no evidence of other PG&E customers being handled differently. PG&E states that it backbills all customers with inoperable meters, except that when the amount is less than \$25, PG&E does not render a backbill due to the administrative costs involved.

We conclude that the billing rendered in the amount of \$402.48 for the billing period, April 9 to May 10, 1990, is reasonable. The complaint is denied.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

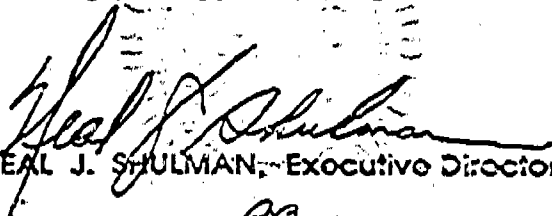
1. The complaint in Case 91-03-054 is denied.
2. The \$402.48 fee impounded by the Commission shall be disbursed to Pacific Gas and Electric Company.
