Statement of Pacts

The dispute which precipitated this complaint is over payment for water usage significantly higher at the time in question than the previous average usage for this commercial complainant.

An evidentiary hearing was duly noticed for 10:00 a.m., Friday, May 17, 1991 in the Council Chambers at the San Jose City Hall. Defendant's representative and witnesses appeared on time ready to proceed. Complainant did not appear. After waiting a half hour without complainant appearing, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) submitted the matter.

At approximately 10:35 a.m. that morning a woman stating she was the wife of the complainant telephoned the Calendar Clerk in San Francisco to state that the claimant was "involved in an audit" and would not appear. Later she also left a message on the ALJ's office recorder asking that the matter be reset for another day.

Discussion

Lost time wastes resources and costs money. While audits are usually scheduled in advance, even if here it was not, the failure of the complainant to telephone the Calendar Clerk early enough to permit cancellation of the hearing and notice to the defendant and the ALJ, thereby saving defendant's representative and several witnesses, and the ALJ, the morning's time, is inexcusable. The Commission's time and resources are limited.
