ORDER DENYING REHEARING

Pacific Bell (Pacific) has applied for rehearing of D.91-10-047, arguing that the Commission has failed to apply applicable Commission orders; has failed to make findings on the application of such orders; and errs in finding that Pacific is not likely to prevail on the merits and that there is no irreparable harm to Pacific. Additionally, Pacific seeks modification of D.91-10-047 to require additional certifications, acknowledgements and disclaimers by defendants, or, alternatively, to set immediate hearings.

Pacific's arguments are addressed to the final disposition of its complaint; no basis is shown that the Commission has abused its discretion in denying the interim relief requested, or that modifications to D.91-10-047 are required at this time.

WHEREFORE,


IT IS ORDERED that Pacific's application for rehearing of D.91-10-047 is denied.
