ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Frank Howard (complainant) sues Southern California Gas Company for reparation for excessively high gas bills. The matter was set for hearing on February 16, 1990, but was taken off calendar at the request of complainant. In March 1991, the assigned Administrative Law Judge wrote to complainant's attorney stating that the complaint would be dismissed if complainant was not prepared to go to hearing by September 30, 1991. Complainant has not responded to that letter.

IT IS ORDERED that this complaint is dismissed, with prejudice, for failure to prosecute.
