O P I N I O N

California League of Food Processors (CLFP) filed the instant complaint against Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) and petition to modify Resolution G-2948. Both seek changes to gas utility rules. A prehearing conference was held in these consolidated proceedings to identify outstanding issues. Many issues either had been resolved between the parties or were subjects of rulemaking proceedings. Subsequently, the assigned administrative law judge issued a ruling stating that the only remaining issue in these proceedings concerned the date by which customers must apply for classification to noncore status. This issue is now the subject of consideration in Application 91-06-045 and Rulemaking 90-02-008.

All unresolved issues in these consolidated proceedings are subjects of other proceedings where the Commission is reviewing the issues in the broader context of gas rules generally. CLFP is

a party to those other proceedings. Accordingly, we will dismiss this complaint against PG&E and the petition to modify Resolution G-2948.

Finding of Fact

Unresolved issues in these consolidated proceedings are subjects of other proceedings in which CLFP is a party.

Conclusion of Law

The Commission should dismiss these proceedings because unresolved issues are subjects of other proceedings.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Case 91-07-024 is dismissed.
2. Application 91-07-022 is dismissed.
