ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Global Telcoin, Inc. (applicant) filed this application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (CPC&N) to operate as a reseller of telecommunications services and operator services within California.

On July 8, 1991, the administrative law judge (ALJ) wrote to applicant to inform it of several deficiencies in the application and of the means by which such deficiencies could be corrected. Among other deficiencies, the ALJ directed the applicant to provide a copy of its articles of incorporation and to substantiate that it has sufficient financial resources to begin its requested operations.

Having received no communications from applicant, the ALJ issued a ruling on October 24, 1991 directing applicant to correct the deficiencies identified in its application within 45 days, by December 9, 1991. The ruling also stated that if applicant failed to correct the deficiencies by December 9, 1991, the ALJ would recommend to the Commission that the application be dismissed with prejudice.

Applicant has not responded to the ALJ's July 8, 1991 letter or to the ALJ's October 24, 1991 ruling. Applicant has not prosecuted the matter with due diligence. Therefore, we will dismiss the application with prejudice for lack of prosecution.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant filed its application for a CPC&N to operate as a reseller of interexchange telecommunications services and operator services within the State of California on May 20, 1991.

2. Applicant has not responded to the ALJ's July 8, 1991 letter or October 24, 1991 ruling requesting applicant to correct certain deficiencies noted in applicant's application.

3. Applicant has not prosecuted the application with due diligence.

Conclusion of Law

The application should be dismissed with prejudice for applicant's lack of prosecution.

IT IS ORDERED that Application 91-05-045 of Global Telcoin, Inc. is dismissed with prejudice.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
