ORDER MODIFYING SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

American Telephone Network, Inc. (ATN) has requested a waiver of the provision of Rule 18(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure that requires service of this application on entities with which ATN is likely to compete and on the cities and counties within which service will be rendered in exercise of the requested certificate.


As an alternate to its blanket exemption request, ATN has requested that only the first eleven (11) pages of the application be served on the entities with which it is likely to compete. Exhibits A through H, attached to the application, would not be served on the competitors. There would still be no service on the cities and counties in which service will be rendered.

In the circumstances of this application, service on the cities and counties would be burdensome and would serve no purpose. However, service should be made on the entities with which applicant is likely to compete. Therefore, ATN's alternate service proposal should be implemented.


Under Resolution ALJ-162, dated February 5, 1992, American Telephone Network, Inc.'s alternate exemption request is granted, effective today. ATN shall file an amendment

to its application certifying that a copy of the application consisting of 11 pages has been served upon or mailed to each party with which it is likely to compete.
