

ORDER PARTIALLY WAIVING SERVICE REQUIREMENTS


Applicant has requested waiver of the provision of Rule 18(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure that requires service of this application on "the cities and counties within which service will be rendered in the exercise of the requested certificate." Resolution ALJ-162 (February 5, 1992) provides "...that the Executive Director may, in special cases and for good cause shown, permit deviations from the service requirements of Rule 18(b)."

In this case, service on the cities and counties would be burdensome and would serve no purpose. Therefore, applicant need not serve all cities and counties in the entire state. Rather, applicant shall serve the application, as amended, on the cities of San Diego and Los Angeles, and the counties of San Diego and Los Angeles.
