


ORDER WAIVING SERVICE REQUIREMENTS

Applicant has requested waiver of the provision of Rule 18(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure that requires service of this application on "the cities or counties within which service will be rendered in the exercise of the requested certificate." Applicant also requests that it be permitted to serve competitors with a summary of its application, rather than the complete application, to comply with Rule 18(b). In the circumstances of this application, service on the cities and counties would be burdensome and would serve no purpose. Likewise, for good cause shown, service of a summary of the application on competitors will in this case be sufficient to comply with Rule 18(b). Under Resolution ALJ-162, the request for waiver and the request to serve a summary are granted, effective today.
