ORDER CORRECTING MINISTERIAL ERROR

On January 10, 1992, the Commission issued an Interim Decision in this proceeding, D.92-01-016. There are two ministerial errors in the ordering paragraphs of that decision which we herein correct.

Ordering Paragraph 5 omits the phrase "and/or RTU operations" which serves to exclude GTEC from the required filing. This phrase should have been included. Parties such as GTEC now included in this requirement may file proposed accounting procedures on or before July 1, 1992.

Ordering Paragraph 9 erroneously refers to the filing of an "advice letter" instead of an application. Under Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The first sentence of Ordering Paragraph 5 is amended to read: "Within 120 days after the effective date of this order, each LEC shall mail to all parties proposed accounting procedures to separate an affiliated RTU and/or RTU operations, and develop a uniform accounting system that produces a fully distributed profit and loss statement with separate accountability of assets."

2. The time for filing comments in compliance with the amended Ordering Paragraph 5 is extended to July 15, 1992.

3. The first sentence of Ordering Paragraph 9 is amended to read: "Within 150 days after the effective date of this order, each LEC offering RTU interconnection services shall file an application proposing a tariff for RTU interconnection services, facilities, terms, conditions and rates."

This order is effective today.
