ORDER EXTENDING STAY OF DECISION 92-04-052

California Trucking Association has filed an application for rehearing of Decision (D.) 92-04-052. This application was filed in time to invoke the automatic stay provisions of Public Utilities Code Section 1733(a). Subsequently, the Ad Hoc Carriers Committee and Frank C. Allegre Trucking, Inc. also filed applications for rehearing of D.92-04-052. We are currently considering the merits of these applications. However, unless we take action today to extend it, the stay of D.92-04-052 will expire before we convene our next meeting. In fairness to applicants, we will extend the stay.
