ORDER CORRECTING INADVERTENT ERROR

In Decision (D.) 92-07-026, issued July 1, 1992, the Commission denied Californía Industrial Group's (CIG) application for rehearing (application) of D.92-03-091 as untimely filed. its decision the Commission noted that CIG's application was delivered to the Commission on May 6, 1992. To be considered timely under Public Utilities Code § 1731(b), CIG's application should have been delivered to the Commission and tendered for filing no later than May 1, 1992.

Subsequent to issuance of D.92-07-026, CIG delivered to the Commission a copy of a Federal Express record which confirmed that CIG's application had been delivered to the Commission's mail room on May 1, 1992, and therefore was not untimely. It appears that a delay in mail processing, due to the April 30 and May 1 closure of the State Building following the Rodney King verdict, caused the Commission to conclude that the filing was untimely. This was erroneous.

Under Resolution A-4661, IT IS ORDERED that Decision (D.) 92-07-026 is hereby vacated, in order to allow the Commission to consider the merits of California Industrial Group's application for rehearing of D.92-03-091 and Pacific Gas and Electric Company's related Motion for Leave to Accept Late Filing.
