ORDER OF DISMISSAL

American Paging, Inc. (of California) (hereinafter API) and Beep California, Inc. (Beep) filed a joint application with the California Public Utilities Commission (Commission) on February 5, 1992. The application, which was published in the Commission's Daily Calendar of February 14, 1992, requests that the Commission grant authority for the sale and transfer by API to Beep of API's certificates of public convenience and necessity to provide one-way and two-way public land mobile radiotelephone service in and around the Sacramento, San Francisco, and San Jose areas.

Beep's proposed acquisition of API's facilities is the subject of an Asset Purchase Agreement dated August 15, 1991 (Agreement) between API, the seller, and Beep, the buyer. A copy of the Agreement was attached to the joint application.

Copies of the application were mailed to other paging companies in California. No protests were filed in connection with the application.

In a June 19, 1992 letter to the assigned Administrative Law Judge, the attorney for API informed the Commission that on June 8, 1992, API cancelled the Agreement with Beep. Due to the cancellation of the Agreement with Beep, API requests that

Upon written request of the applicant, A.92-02-013 is dismissed under Public Utilities Code § 308 and Resolution A-4638, effective today.
