## ORDER CORRECTING ERROR

On September 2, 1992, in Decision (D.) 92-09-024, the Commission directed Pacific Bell and GTE California to offer inside wire (IW) insurance to landlords. D.92-09-024 also provides guidance to other local exchange companies (LECs) that decide to offer IW insurance to landlords, and requires LECs to instruct customers about residential landlords' legal responsibilities whenever marketing IW insurance or repairs.

In the order, the Commission provided the disclosure statement LECs would make when marketing IW repairs or insurance on page 6, in Conclusion of Law 3, and in Ordering Paragraph 4, as follows:

"You should be aware that, under state law, landlords, and not tenants, are responsible for repairs to and maintenance of inside telephone wire."

This was a clerical error. The correct statement is:

"You should be aware that, under state law, residential landlords and not tenants, are responsible for repairs and maintenance of residential inside telephone wire."

Under Resolution A-4661, which authorizes the Executive Director to sign, on behalf of the Commission, orders involving the correction of typographical and clerical errors in the decisions

and orders of the Commission, this order will correct the above error.

IT IS ORDERED that Decision 92-09-024 is amended by changing the statement on page 6, Conclusion of Law 3, and in Ordering Paragraph 4 to read as follows:

"You should be aware that, under state law, residential landlords and not tenants, are responsible for repairs and maintenance of residential inside telephone wire."

This order is effective today.
