ORDER DENYING  
REHEARING OF DECISION 92640

An application for rehearing of Decision (D.) 92640 has been filed by San Bernardino Valley Municipal Water District (District). Responses thereto have been filed by Southern California Edison Company (Edison) and the Commission staff.

Edison has also filed a petition for modification pursuant to Rule 43 of our Rules of Practice and Procedure.

We have carefully considered each allegation of error in the District's petition and are of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been shown.

As to Edison's request that D.92640 be modified, the record in this proceeding supports a preliminary conclusion that the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station Unit No. 1 (SONGS 1) is an appropriate facility for implementing a performance standard incentive program similar to those adopted for Edison's coal fired facilities. However, we realize this was

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not an active issue during the proceeding and more evidence on this question might have led to a different conclusion. Therefore, we expect the consultant employed by Edison to address this question and include conclusions and recommendations as a part of its report. These will assist us in making a final determination as to whether such a program for SONGS 1 should be implemented.

No further issues require comment. Therefore,  
IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that rehearing of D.93640 is denied.


