ORDER EXTENDING SUSPENSION

Rate Reduction 606 (RR-606) filed October 29, 1981 by Di Salvo Trucking Co. contains reduced rates for the transportation of drugs, medicines, and toilet preparations tendered by one shipper in quantities of 5,000 pounds or more from Metropolitan Zone 111 to points within 525 constructive miles. By letter dated November 27, 1981, the Executive Director, under authority of Resolution M-4713, suspended the rates in RR-606 for a period of 45 days in response to a protest filed by Adams Delivery Service, Inc. The 45-day suspension period of RR-606 is scheduled to expire January 11, 1982.

A public hearing in Case (C.) 11046 is scheduled on January 28, 1982. In order that the suspension period may be continued until a decision on the issues raised in C.11046 may be made on the record developed at the public hearing, RR-606 should be suspended for a further period beyond the current expiration date.

IT IS ORDERED that the tariff provisions contained in RR-606 of Di Salvo Trucking Co., which were suspended November 27, 1981, are further suspended and the use of RR-606 is deferred until further order of the Commission.


