ORDER CORRECTING DECISION 93727

The Commission has been informed that a computational error appears in Decision (D.) 93727, dated November 13, 1981 in the above-entitled matter as follows: On all pages of D.93727 and the attached Appendix A, where the California Safe Drinking Water Bond Act of 1976 (SDWBA) rate surcharge is indicated, such surcharge amounts should be based on a bimonthly rather than a monthly rate to be paid by the customers of Bodfish Water Company, Inc. (Bodfish). The corrections are as follows:

a. Page 4, last paragraph, the last three lines on the page should read "requiring an increase in water rates of approximately \$6.35 bimonthly for each residential customer with a 5/8-inch x 3/4-inch meter".

b. Page 5, in the Surcharge Schedule, the column heading entitled "Monthly Surcharge" should read "Bimonthly Surcharge".

c. Page 10. Finding of Fact 7 should read "The rate surcharge will increase Bodfish's annual gross revenues by approximately \$22,860 and increase water rates by approximately \$6.35 bimonthly for an average residential customer with a 5/8-inch by 3/4-inch meter."


d. In APPENDIX A, Page 1, Schedule 1A, ANNUAL METERED SERVICE, the column heading entitled "Per Meter Per Month Surcharge" should read "Per Meter Per Bimonthly Surcharge". In the same schedule the paragraph entitled "METERED SERVICE SURCHARGE", the first two sentences should read, "NOTE: This surcharge is in addition to the regular bimonthly metered water bill. The total bimonthly surcharge must be identified on each bill."

IT IS ORDERED that the above specified corrections be made as indicated.
