ORDER MODIFYING DECISION 93378

By Decision (D.) 93378 in Application 60519 Hendrix Electronics, Inc., dba Cal-Com Radio Telephone Service, was granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing it to construct and operate an extension of its public utility radiotelephone system located in El Centro and Blythe, California, as requested in the application.

In Ordering Paragraphs 3 and 4 of D.93378 we inadvertently made reference to the City of El Centro, California, when we should instead have made reference to the City of Blythe, California. Accordingly, D.93378 should be modified by revising Ordering Paragraphs 3 and 4 to reflect the correct city.

We find that public convenience and necessity require modifications be made in D.93378.

IT IS ORDERED that the following ordering paragraphs in Decision 93378 are changed to read as follows:

Ordering Paragraph 3, page 5:

"3. Applicant shall file, within 30 days of the date the authority is to become operational, tariffs containing the schedule of rates and charges applicable to its radiotelephone service in and around Blythe, California, as authorized by this Commission."

Ordering Paragraph 4, page 5:


"4. The certificate granted and the authority to render service under the current rates, charges, and tariffs used for applicant's Blythe radiotelephone service will expire if not exercised within one year after the effective date of this order."

This order is effective today.
