ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision 90150 dated April 10, 1979, Sierra Pacific Power Company (Sierra Pacific) was ordered to file its "Proposed Conservation Program Reports" annually. Reports were filed December 1, 1979 and December 1, 1980. Sierra Pacific's 1981 report has not yet been filed.

By petition filed December 11, 1981 Sierra Pacific requested that it be allowed until January 29, 1982 to file its 1981 report. As justification for the late filing, Sierra Pacific states:

"On November 13, 1981, the Commission issued general rate Decision No. 93771, which contained several directives related to Petitioner's conservation programs. Sierra Pacific employees met with CPUC staff members on November 23, 1981, to discuss compliance with these directives, and a follow-up meeting was held between the employees and Petitioner's senior management on December 3, 1981. Due to the policy and operating changes that resulted from this series of events, the 1981 report on proposed conservations measures was not filed on December 1."

After consideration of the information contained in the petition, we conclude that the request shall be granted. Because of the time constraints this order should be effective today.


IT IS ORDERED that the time for Sierra Pacific Power Company to file its 1981 Proposed Conservation Program Report is extended to January 29, 1982.
