O P I N I O N

By this petition, Bacon Ready Mix, Inc. seeks modification of Section 3 of Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A (MRT 17-A). MRT 17-A names minimum rates for the transportation of property in dump truck equipment from defined production areas to designated delivery zones and points in Southern California. Section 3 of the tariff names specific delivery points for application of Area-to-Point rates. The Area-to-Point rates are 3 cents per ton less than the other applicable zone rates.

Petitioner is in the business of manufacturing, marketing and distributing rock, sand, and gravel products and seeks to include its plant as a named delivery point within Section 3 of the tariff. If granted, petitioner would be entitled to a rate reduction of 3 cents per ton from applicable zone rates.

A staff field survey has determined that the petitioner's plant conforms to the delivery point criteria established by Decision (D.) 57675 dated December 2, 1958 and D.80810, dated December 12, 1972 in Case 5437.

Copies of the petition were served on various known carriers' organizations on or about November 5, 1981. The petition was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar of November 12, 1981. No objection to the granting of the petition has been received.

Findings of Fact

1. The establishment of an additional delivery point, Bacon Ready Mix, Inc. at Montebello, Delivery Zone 19421, will result in just, reasonable, and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation involved.

2. The following order has no reasonably foreseeable impact upon the energy efficiency of dump truck carriers.

3. A public hearing is not necessary.

Conclusion of Law

The petition should be granted.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A (Appendix C of D.80578, as amended) is further amended by incorporating attached Fifth Revised Page 3-1 and Fifth Revised Page 3-2 to become effective 39 days after the date of this order.

2. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are subject to D.80578, as amended, are authorized to establish in their tariffs the amendment necessary to conform with the further adjustments ordered by this decision.

3. Tariff publications authorized to be made by common carriers as a result of this order may be made effective not earlier than 39 days after the date of this order, and may be made effective on not less than 5 days' notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than 60 days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

4. Common carriers in establishing and maintaining the amendment authorized by this order are authorized to depart from the provisions of PU Code Section 461.5 to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order;

and schedules containing the amendment published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

5. In all other respects D.80578, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

6. The Executive Director shall service a copy of this decision on every common carrier, or such carriers' authorized tariff publishing agents, performing transportation services subject to Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A.


7. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of the tariff amendment on each subscriber to Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A.
